# MARYLAND BALLOT ACCESS ENCUMBRANCE

Without objection, Mr. Hagan moved to increase the encumbrance for the Maryland ballot access drive by \$1,300, thereby making the amount \$16,300. [200509-1]

#### ALASKA LAWSUIT AND BALLOT ACCESS PETITIONING

Richard Winger and Chris Wiest were recognized from the gallery to give an explanation of the legal background behind a pending lawsuit in Alaska.

Alaska Libertarian Party Chair Jon Watts was recognized to give an update on the petitioning efforts.

Without objection, Mr. Redpath moved that the LNC encumber \$15,000 for an Alaska petition drive and litigation in 2020. [200509-2]
